Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible, nominees must meet all the following criteria:

- Is 10 to 30 years of age as of March 31, 2021;
- Plays an active role in making a positive difference and models civic engagement globally and/or locally;
- Currently resides in Alberta, is affiliated with one of ACGC's member organizations abroad, is enrolled in a post-secondary program in Alberta while residing outside of Alberta, or is a resident of Alberta residing elsewhere;
- Is willing to participate in the creation of the publication, where their information and picture(s) will be displayed to the general public; and
- Is easily contacted (in Canada or otherwise reachable).

Nominee Information

We require the following information of nominees.

- First and last name
- Place of residence
- Phone number
- Email address
- Date of birth
- Gender
- Is the nominee aware of this nomination?

Nominator Information

We require the following information of nominators.

- First and last name
- Phone numbers
- Email address
- Relationship to nominee



Eligibility

The online form will ask you two questions to verify the nominee's eligibility.

- Is the nominee between 10-30 years of age as of March 31, 2021?
- Is the nominee (a) currently residing in Alberta, (b) affiliated or working with an ACGC member abroad, (c) studying outside Alberta but considers Alberta their permanent home?

Character of Nominee

Through the following questions, the online form will ask you to explain what makes this nominee special.

- Why are you compelled to nominate the nominee? (Max 3,000 characters)
- Please provide examples of collaborative projects (local or global) that the nominee has contributed to and describe the nominee's role for each of the, (Max 3,000 characters)
- How is the nominee contributing to the Sustainable Development Goals? (See at <https://sustainabledevelopment.un.org> – Max of 3,000 characters)
- How is the nominee working towards gender equality and the empowerment of women and girls?
- For this year's Top 30 Under 30 campaign, we have chosen to highlight how youth work in solidarity with individuals and organizations in their community(ies) to address pressing issues. Describe ways in which this nominee practice collaboration in their work.

Nominators will also have the option to upload up to 3 supplementary materials, such as letters of recommendation, articles, etc.
